This Fellowship Award is the highest form of recognition, at the club level, and embodies humanitarian ideas consistent with the nature and purpose of Lionism. This award is \$1000US.




LFC Judge Brian Stevenson Fellowship Award

To recognize outstanding Canadian Lions and other deserving recipients, PIP Judge Brian Stevenson has endorsed this Fellowship. This recognition is one of the greatest honors that can be bestowed in Lionism in Canada. This Fellowship should be treated as recognition of achievement or involvement and the presentation ceremony will honour the person and their accomplishments. The recipient will receive a Judge Brian Stevenson medallion, lapel pin and signed certificate. The Judge Brian Stevenson Fellowship is available to purchase for \$500 by a Club, district, multiple district, or an individual who wishes to honour someone. No personal purchases. Based on Judge Brian Stevenson's request, the funds are used to build an endowment fund to ensure a strong future for Lions Foundation of Canada as they continue to provide Dog Guides. 
